

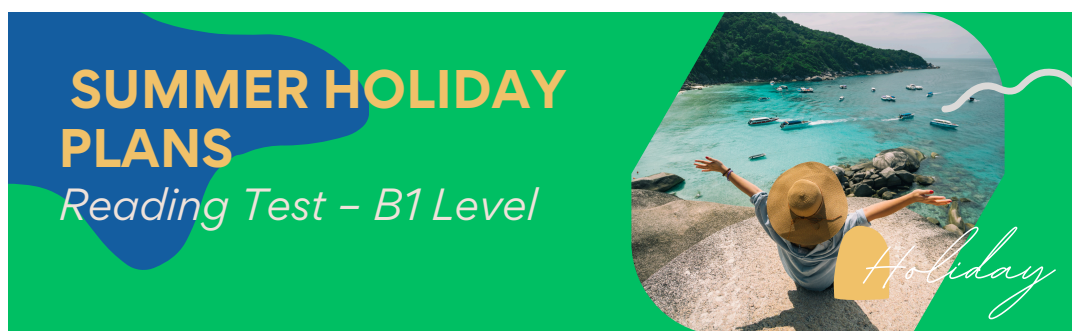

Holiday Destinations



A. Greenhill Campsite

Set in a national park, this campsite is ideal for people who enjoy sleeping in tents and being outdoors. There are guided walks, forest trails, and wildlife watching. The scenery is perfect for nature lovers and photographers

B. Suncoast Resort

This peaceful resort has a private beach and a swimming pool. There are daily yoga sessions and sailing lessons for beginners. Most guests come here to relax and enjoy nature, although there are many activities for children too.

C. Hotel Aurora

Located in a small, quiet town, this hotel has lovely views and a traditional restaurant serving local dishes. There are no sports facilities, but guests can enjoy reading by the pool or walking in the nearby countryside

D. Costa Family Resort

This family-friendly hotel includes meals and snacks. There's a kids' club with games, swimming, and movie nights, while adults can enjoy the gym, spa, and evening shows

E. City Central Hostel

This modern hostel is great for groups of friends. It's in the middle of a lively city with bars, clubs, and galleries. Guests can get discounted travel cards for buses and trains

F. Mountain Lodge

Stay in a comfortable cabin at the base of the hills, with beautiful views. Guests can enjoy short nature walks in the mornings or simply relax in the lodge's library with books and board games. Meals are served in a large dining hall with mountain views

G. Bluewater Hotel

A popular hotel with sailing and windsurfing lessons for all levels. There's also a kids' club, two swimming pools, and tennis courts. It's close to several restaurants and shops

H. Coral Beach Villas

These villas are a short walk from the beach. The atmosphere is quiet, and the beach isn't crowded. There are no group activities, but there's a small café that serves fresh, healthy food
