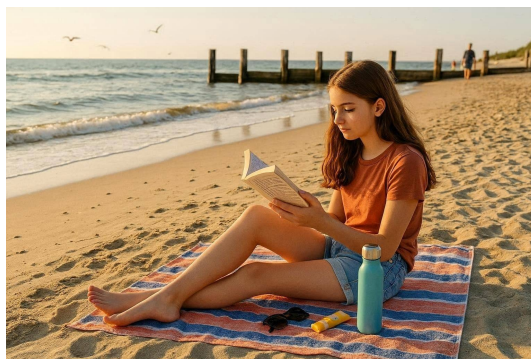

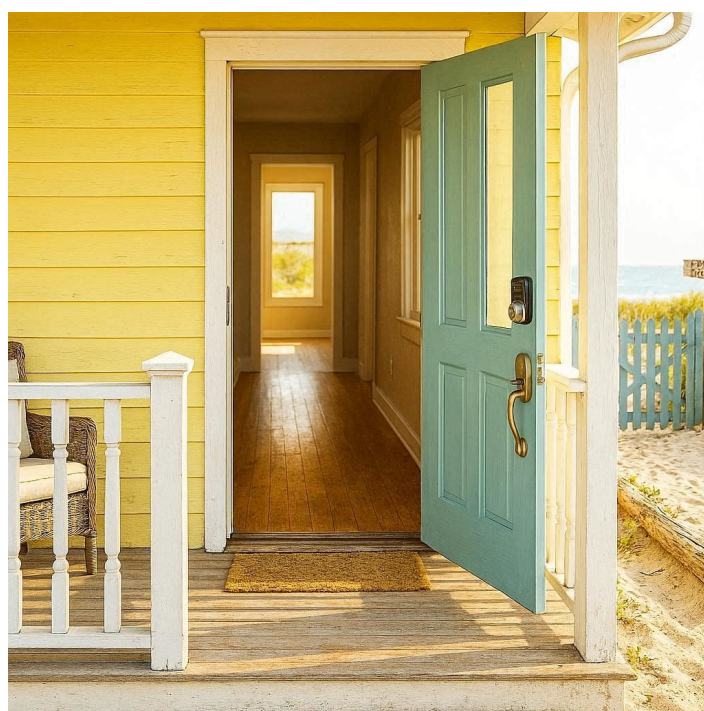

Puzzle 1 — Packing list

HAT, CAP, SHORTS, SANDALS, MAP, SHELL. Things you can wear: HAT, CAP, SHORTS, SANDALS. → DIGIT 1 = 4

Puzzle 2 — Past simple

walked, went, played, swam, watched. Irregular forms: went, swam. → DIGIT 2 = 2

Puzzle 3 — Odd one out

Set A: HELMET (sunscreen, towel and goggles are all used at the beach/pool; helmet is for cycling/skiing). Set B: TRAVEL (trip, journey and holiday are all nouns for a specific trip; travel is a general verb/concept). Set C: CASTLE (hostel, resort and hotel are all holiday destinations or places to stay; castle is not). Set D: BUCKET (beach, shore and coast all describe the edge of the sea; bucket does not). All odd words have 6 letters. → DIGIT 3 = 6 (6 letters in every odd word: HELMET, TRAVEL, CASTLE, BUCKET)

Puzzle 4 — Prepositions
