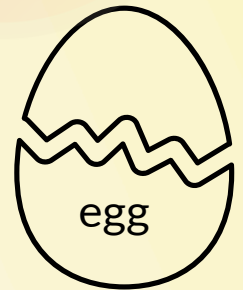

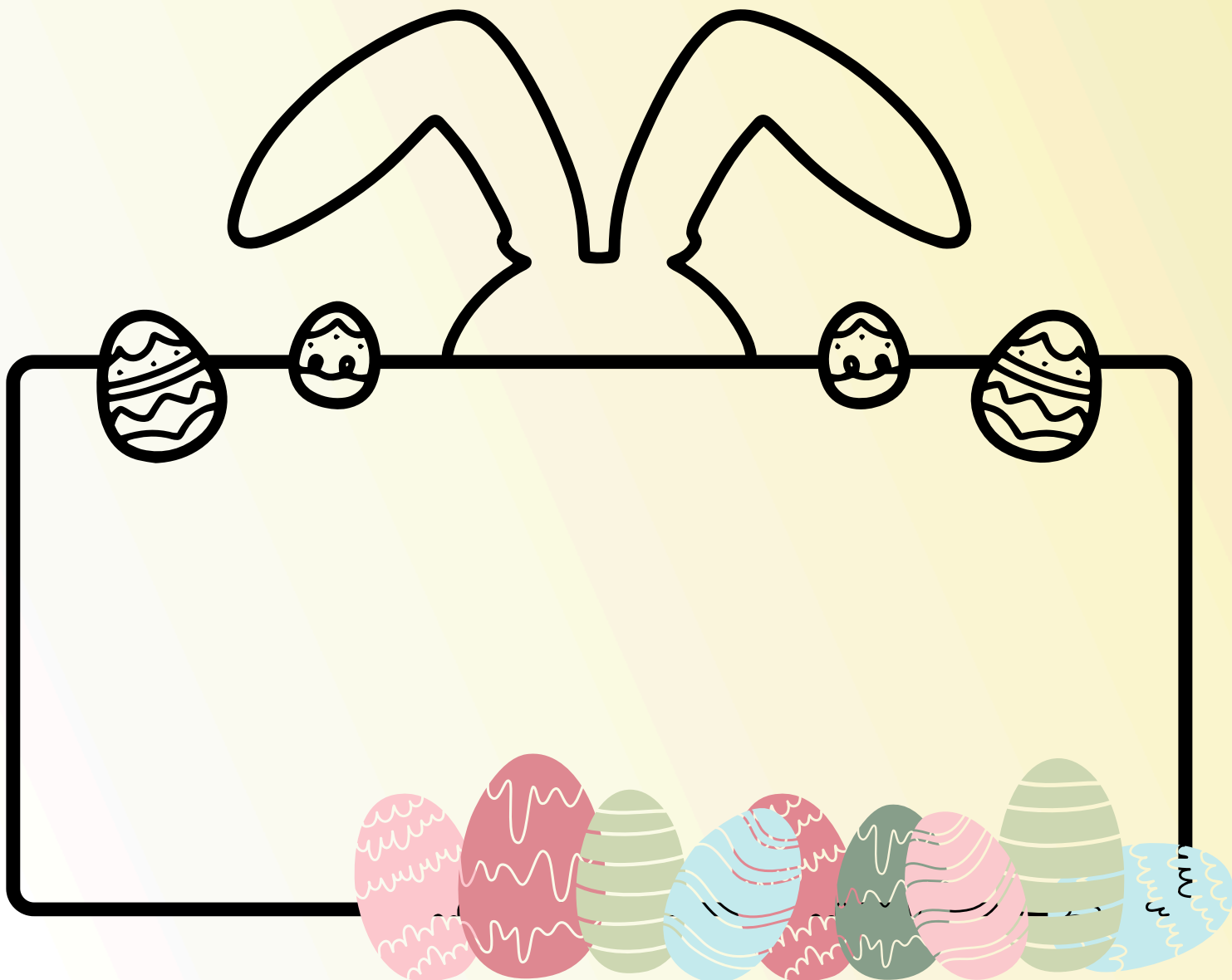

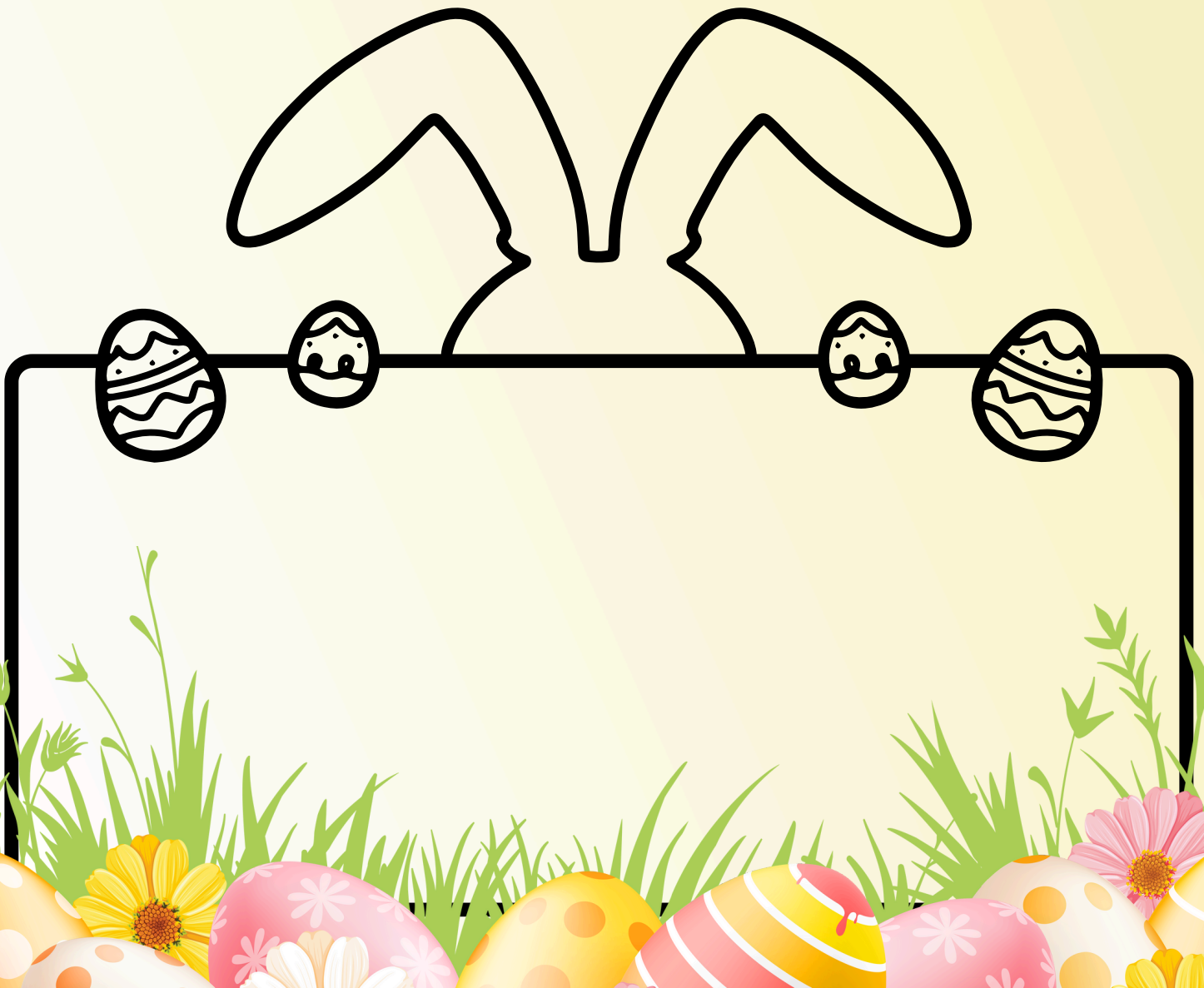

Solve five Easter-themed "Who Am I?" riddles by using the clues to guess the correct answer!

- 1.** I hop around, I have big ears, and I bring treats once a year. **Who am I?**
- 2.** You paint me, you hide me, and children love to find me. **What am I?**
- 3.** I am soft and yellow, I say "cheep cheep," and I hatch from an egg. **Who am I?**
- 4.** I carry eggs and treats, you can hold me with one hand. **What am I?**
- 5.** You unwrap me, you eat me, and I taste sweet. **What am I?**





Solve a short logic puzzle about the Easter Bunny delivering eggs.

"The Easter Bunny is carrying six eggs: a **red** egg, a **blue** egg, a **green** egg, a **yellow** egg, a **purple** egg, and an **orange** egg. He needs to deliver them to three children: **Emma, Jack, and Lily**. Here are the clues to figure out who gets which egg:"

- Emma **does not like warm colors** (red, orange, yellow).
- Jack's **favorite color is blue** and he also gets one other egg.
- Lily **loves bright colors**, but she **does not get the blue** egg.
- Each child gets two eggs in total.





Solve four Easter-themed puzzles to crack a 4-digit code and unlock the Easter Bunny's treasure!

"The Easter Bunny has hidden his chocolate eggs inside a locked chest! The only way to open it is by solving four challenges to find the secret 4-digit code."

🧩 Puzzle 1: The Missing Egg Mystery (First Digit)

"The Easter Bunny counted his eggs before hiding them. He had 23 eggs, but a sneaky squirrel stole some! Now there are only 17 left. How many eggs are missing?"

🧩 Puzzle 2: The Bunny's Hopping Challenge (Second Digit)

"The Easter Bunny hops in a special pattern to reach the golden egg. He hops 3 steps forward, 2 steps back, then 4 steps forward. How many steps does he move forward in total?"

✿ **Puzzle 3: The Easter Basket Logic Puzzle (Third Digit)**

"Lily, Noah, Emma, and Jake each brought a different Easter treat: chocolate eggs, jelly beans, carrot cake, and marshmallow chicks. Use the clues to find out who brought the chocolate eggs!"

Clues:

- Lily didn't bring something sweet.
 - Noah brought something colorful but not chocolate.
 - Emma didn't bring jelly beans.

✿ **Puzzle 4: The Colorful Egg Hunt (Fourth Digit)**

"In a garden, there are 12 Easter eggs: some are blue, some are yellow, and some are green. There are 5 blue eggs and twice as many yellow eggs as green ones. How many green eggs are there?"

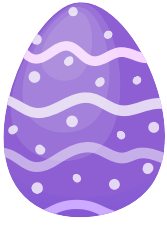

CHALLENGE #1

🔊 Once completed, they get the letter E.

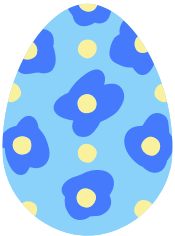

🔊 Once they decode it, they get the letter A.

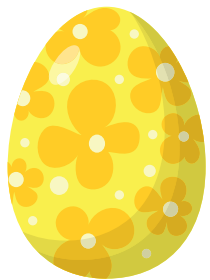
CHALLENGE #3

CHALLENGE #4



1. I hop around, I have big ears, and I bring treats once a year. Who am I? **(Easter Bunny)**
2. You paint me, you hide me, and children love to find me. What am I? **(Easter Egg)**
3. I am soft and yellow, I say "cheep cheep," and I hatch from an egg. Who am I? **(Chick)**
4. I carry eggs and treats, you can hold me with one hand. What am I? **(Basket)**
5. You unwrap me, you eat me, and I taste sweet. What am I? **(Chocolate)**

CHALLENGE #5



- Emma gets: Green & Purple
 - Jack gets: Blue & Orange
 - Lily gets: Red & Yellow
- Once they solve the puzzle, they get the letter R.

CHALLENGE #6

Puzzle 1: The Missing Egg Mystery (First Digit)

✓ Solution: $23 - 17 = 6$

The first digit of the code is 6.

Puzzle 2: The Bunny's Hopping Challenge (Second Digit)

✓ Solution: $(3 \text{ forward} - 2 \text{ back}) + 4 \text{ forward} = 5 \text{ steps forward}$

The second digit of the code is 5.

Puzzle 3: The Easter Basket Logic Puzzle (Third Digit)

✓ Solution:

Lily → Carrot Cake

Noah → Jelly Beans

Emma → Marshmallow Chicks

Jake → Chocolate Eggs

The third digit of the code is 3 (because Jake has 3 letters in his name!).

Puzzle 4: The Colorful Egg Hunt (Fourth Digit)

✓ Solution:

Let G = number of green eggs.

Then yellow eggs = $2G$.

Equation: $5 \text{ (blue)} + G \text{ (green)} + 2G \text{ (yellow)} = 12$

Solve for G → Green eggs = 2

The fourth digit of the code is 2.

Final Answer: The Secret Code is 6532!

Once they unlock the Bunny's treasure, they get the letter R!

Final Step: Form the Word EASTER!

Once they collect all letters (E - A - S - T - E - R), they win! You can reward them with small Easter treats like stickers, chocolates, or a certificate.
